





### Testing Time:

2 hours and 45 minutes (about  $3 \frac{1}{2}$  hours total)

## • The PSAT/NMSQT Measures:

- Critical reading, mathematical reasoning, and writing skills that are important for success in college; accumulative knowledge and skills; ability to reason
  - Reading: 47 questions
  - Writing/Language: 44 questions
  - Math no calculator: 17 questions
  - Math calculator: 31 questions

### Scoring:

- Scale of 320–1520
- Correct answer= 1 point
- Omitted question = no points
- Wrong answers = no points lost

You will not be asked to recall facts from literature, history, or science, or to complete math formulas, because this test measures your reasoning and critical thinking skills.


